Sylvan Terrace & The Jumel Terrace Historic District
High Bridge Park

There are some areas along the trail where lunch may be purchased. Washington Heights has an abundance of Dominican cafés that you may want to visit for an exceptional eating and cultural experience.”

Transportation: 6:03 a.m. LIRR train from Huntington to Penn Station. Number 1 Train (subway) uptown to 215th Street and 10th Avenue.

Cost: LIRR – Adults \$9.25 round trip (group rate)
Youth \$6.00 round trip (group rate)
MetroCard - \$6.50 round trip

Bring money for lunch and snacks.

Gear: Day pack with rain gear, extra hat and gloves (weather dependent), compass, personal First Aid kit, headlamp, snacks, WATER, comfort items.

Uniform: FULL Class A uniform.
